Subject: COVID-19 Update - New Zealand remains at Alert Level 2

Importance: High

Good Afternoon

Yesterday Cabinet announced that New Zealand is to remain at Alert Level 2, with the extra restrictions in the Auckland region informally known as Alert Level 2.5 also remaining in place. There are no changes to the operating requirements for businesses and services, so keep on as you have been.

We are seeing a number of clubs on the receiving end of complaints, thankfully we know of none that have resulted in any enforcement action. We urge you to take the time to reinforce the rules with staff and members, document your policies and procedures that are in place and stick to your guns.

The Government will next review the Alert Levels on Monday 21 September. It has agreed, in principle, to move New Zealand down to Alert Level 1 and Auckland to Alert Level 2 with eased restrictions on gatherings. The Government will make a final decision on 21 September.

If the restrictions do change, the date will depend on where you are in New Zealand:

- For Auckland, this will be at 11:59pm on Wednesday 23 September.
- For the rest of New Zealand, this will be at 11:59pm on Monday 21 September.
