The Government has today announced upcoming changes to the countries Alert Levels

Auckland

Auckland will move to Alert Level 2 with no extra restrictions at 11:59pm on Wednesday 23 September. This means people in Auckland will be able to attend social gatherings, funerals and tangihanga in groups of up to 100 people.

The requirement for food and drink businesses to ensure that no more than 10 customers or clients are seated at a table together will also be lifted.

Rest of New Zealand

The rest of New Zealand will move to Alert Level 1 at 11:59pm on Monday 21 September.
