*Remits

Remit 1/ West End Bowling Club.

Remit 2/ That magic racks/Shark racks be forbidden in CNZ National & Island events.

After a short discussion from the floor it was put to the vote.

The remit was voted in favour of removing the Magic rack/Shark rack.

Remit PASSED. To be implemented from 2025.

Remit 3/Players may only play in one Open Island event per calendar year.

Ladies may only play 1 Ladies island event per calendar year.
