Minutes of 2018 moved as correct by Diane Heath - Hornby. Diane advised that the hand written notes are correct but there is still a report to come. Seconded by Helen Banks - Nelson Suburban. All agreed.

Matters Arising: Diane Heath – Hornby, says it was moved and passed at last meeting that tournament expenditure should only go in the folder that goes to the next hosting club and, Clubs NZ. It should not be handed out for discussion at the meeting.

Applications for future tournaments:

- Sherie Seales - Taupo says they will look at hosting in 2021 because technically 2020 should be hosted in the South Island.
- Cathy Morton – Cashmere says they are looking to host the National 500 tournament in the last week of April so asked North Island clubs if they thought it ok for Cashmere to host Cribbage the weekend before 500. Some discussion on dates. ANZAC day is the last weekend of April and clubs can't open until 1pm. This puts that weekend out. Easter is 10th-13th April. Therefore, the Cribbage tournament will need to be held 4th and 5th April OR, 18th and 19th April. Diane Heath – Hornby will discuss with her Board/committee. She will then discuss with Kate at Clubs NZ.

General Business:

1. Warren Pearce – Hamilton WMC submitted a Remit – “Team entries to be a maximum of 6 members”. This was seconded by Bryan Talbot - Porirua Club.
Diane Heath – Hornby says they put the team trophy up. It is just the trophy with no monetary prizes. The intent was for clubs to bring more players. Some discussion on if you reduce the numbers then can you look to increase the number of teams per club. All in all, a ‘robust’ discussion. Found 2008 minutes that stated: there can only be one team of 8 per club. Voted on and motion lost.

3. Warren Pearce – Hamilton WMC explained that his wife fell on a double-decker bus and the Porirua Club has been ‘brilliant’. Anything she wants is provided for and Warrens says thank you very much.

6. Hosting Clubs should have a form to sign for people/clubs taking trophies. The form should have names on it, a blurb saying if trophy is damaged or lost then it is to be fixed or replaced by those that signed for it.
