

REMIT 1 TO CLUBS NEW ZEALAND

SOUTH ISLAND CRIBBAGE PAIRS TOURNAMENT RULES OF PLAY

Date: August 2024

Proposed New Rule:

Clause D

Notwithstanding Clause E below, the host club may provide substitute and/or fill-in players as required, so that complete tables of four players are realised for the entire tournament.

Clause E – renumber existing Clause D as E

Reason for the addition:

There is presently no provision in the rules regarding substitute players.

It is not unusual for the number of registered players to change, usually reduce, right up to tournament day, for a variety of reasons. This can cause problems for the host club achieving complete tables of four players.

As full tables of four players is the target, the host club needs to be able to “plug” gaps wherever they may occur.

REMIT 2 TO CLUBS NEW ZEALAND

SOUTH ISLAND CRIBBAGE PAIRS TOURNAMENT RULES OF PLAY

Date: August 2024

Proposed Amended Rule:

Clause D (will become Clause E if Remit 1 is adopted)

If a single club does not have sufficient players for a team, they may combine with another club/s to make up a composite team.

No player in the composite team shall be from a Club that already has a team entered. Nor can a club provide multiple players for multiple teams.

The Host Club will encourage and may co-ordinate the entry of Composite teams into the competition while ensuring there are no irregularities.

Reason for change:

Existing Clause D is cumbersome.

We have found by experience that opportunities for forming composite teams are usually identified once entries are received.

Clubs can then be approached by the Host Club to see whether they wish to form a composite team with other identified clubs. This may involve more than two Clubs forming one composite team.

This does not stop any Club composing with another themselves and informing the Host of the Composite Team.
