General Business:

- Oxford confirmed they can host 2026 on March 7th & 8th but did stipulate that they have no close accommodation. There are motels at the Westend of Rangiora or alternatively Kaiapoi and Christchurch.

Papanui will possibly put a remit in but rules won't change for 2026.
