AUCKLAND AREA WORKINGMENS AND COSMOPOLITAN CLUBS GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP

RULES OF THE TOURNAMENT

- 1. The Tournament to be known as the Auckland Area Workingmen's and Cosmopolitan Clubs Men's Golf Championship.
- 2. The Tournament to be open to all Workingmen's and Cosmopolitan Clubs in Auckland and North Auckland area which are affiliated to the New Zealand Chartered Clubs Incorporated under their Rule 29/A Category 3.
- 3. Each club to be represented by one team of six players five cards to count.
- 4. The maximum handicap of any player shall be his own clubs slope handicap of 30.0. All players must be members of an affiliated golf club and must produce a certificate of handicap at the date of the Tournament.
- Any individual prize list shall be left to the discretion of the club holding the Tournament but the teams shall play nett for the cup. Winners and runners up in team play may also qualify for individual prizes.
- 6. The Tournament shall be held annually and shall be hosted by clubs in the area in alphabetical order. It shall be played over eighteen holes.
- 7. The rules of play shall be those of the Royal and Ancient Golf of St. Andrews except as varied by the local rules of the host club's course.
- 8. The host club, when making the draw, shall keep the members of a team as close together as practicable in the starting sheet.
- 9. The host club of the year shall present accounts of the Tournament to the area secretary within two months of the completion of the Tournament.
- 10. In the event of a tie, the sixth card shall count, and if still tied the trophy be held jointly and the prizes be decided by lot.
- 11. Where Clubs find themselves in a difficult financial position when hosting a tournament, Clubs may apply for special funding from the associations finances.
 Application for special funding to be made in writing to the Secretary, prior to the next A.G.M. The amount of funding given shall be set by the delegates at the AGM.
