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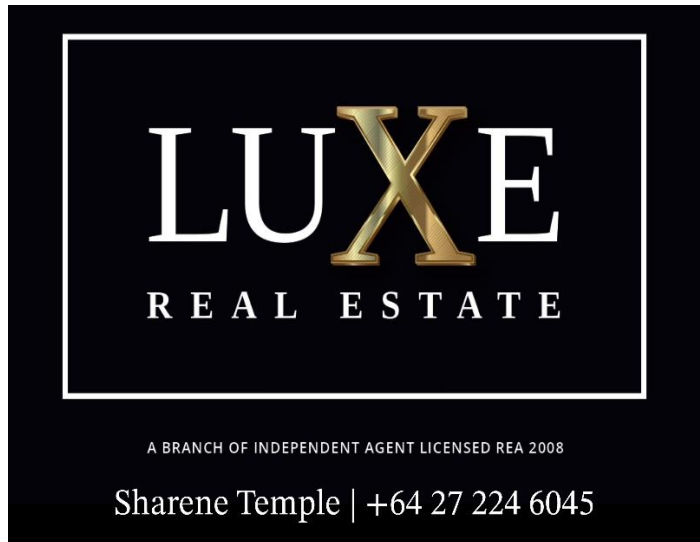

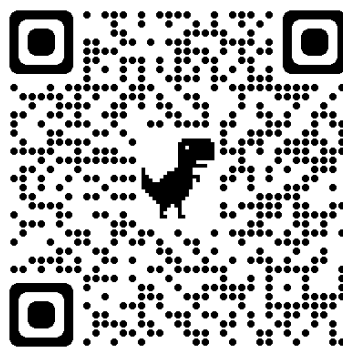

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

CHECK IN – Check in at the Golf Club Pro-Shop at least half an hour prior to tee off each day.

COMPETITION (36 HOLES) – Nett and played off the white tees. The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter the number of holes to be played should circumstances warrant.

RULES – All play to be conducted in accordance with the **Royal & Ancient Rules of Golf** in conjunction with the permanent and temporary **Local Rules** of both Golf Clubs.

RULES OFFICIAL & TOURNAMENT REFEREE – On-course Rules Official and Tournament Referee will be available. They will be in identified golf carts. If you have a ruling that you need clarified, and a Rules Official or Tournament Referee is not in sight, please call 021 504 454 (Glenn Elliot) or 027 472 0274 (John Fox).

DISPUTES – Will be resolved by the Organising Committee and Tournament Officials. Their decision shall be final.

SUSPENSION or ABANDONMENT OF PLAY – Will be signalled by an air horn from the Clubhouse as follows:

Discontinue Play Immediately – One prolonged blast

Discontinue Play – Three consecutive blasts repeated

Resume Play – Two short blasts repeated

NB Where necessary, the Tournament Referee will also advise players of any suspension or abandonment of play.

SLOW PLAY – Please keep in mind the pace of play. Refer to Rule 5.6: Unreasonable Delay; Prompt Pace of Play. Repeated infringements can incur a penalty. A roving Marshall will be on the course to ensure timely flow.

LATE ARRIVAL – Refer to Rule 5.3a: When to Start Round.

GPS – Distance only measuring devices are allowed.

CELLPHONE – Allowed on the course but must be switched OFF.

DISTANCE MARKERS – White 135 metres and Red 100 metres to the centre of the green.

SCORE CARDS – You will be given your scorecard outside the Golf Club Pro-Shop before the start of each round. You must check all the details are correct before teeing off. Local Rules of the Golf Club will be attached. RETURN your SIGNED scorecard to the Golf Club Pro-Shop at the completion of your round. All cards will be retained for handicapping purposes. Digital scoring WILL NOT be accepted.

GENERAL INFORMATION

BREAKFAST – Will be available at both Golf Clubs. Pre-bookings only.

TOILETS: Arikikapakapa Golf Club – Located at the end of the 5th and the 8th green.

TOILETS: Springfield Golf Club – Located beside the 8th green.

SPOTTERS: Arikikapakapa Golf Club – Will be at the 5th, 7th, 13th and 14th fairways.

SPOTTERS: Springfield Golf Club – Will be at the 6th, 11th and 15th fairways.

PHOTOGRAPHER – A photographer will be at the Golf Club Pro Shop to take team photos.

GOLF CARTS – Leave keys in the golf cart when finished each day. Cost of hire on practice day is \$50 and cost of hire on tournament days is \$45.

HEALTH & SAFETY

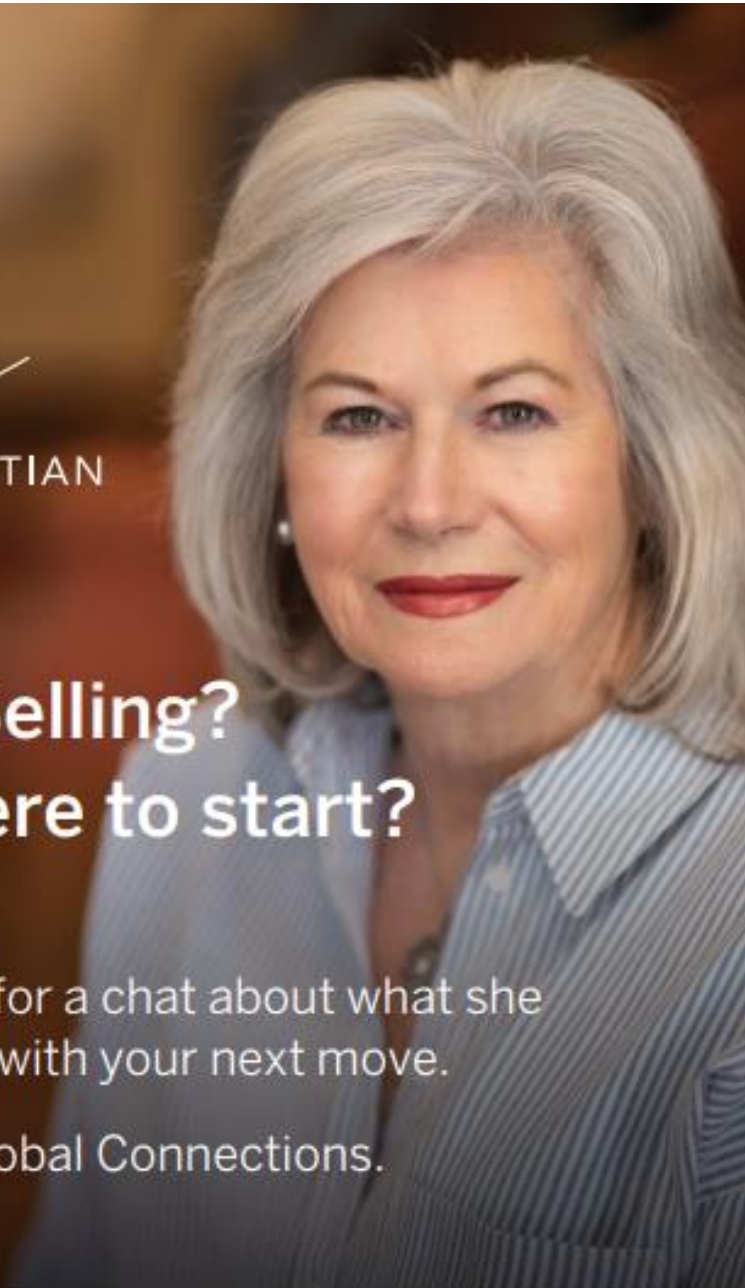

ARIKIPAKAPA-HOME OF ROTORUA GOLF LOCAL RULES

**TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE NOTICE BOARDS IN THE CLUBHOUSE
AND ON THE BACK OF THE SCORECARDS.**

- 1 club length placing (on own mown fairway only).
- If your stance or swing is impeded by exposed matting in a bunker, relief can be obtained via placing at the nearest point of relief in the bunker.
- Out of Bounds/Lost Ball:
 - a) A player can play a provisional shot from the tee with a 1 shot penalty (3rd off the tee).
 - b) A player can drop the ball in a large area between the point where the ball is estimated to have come to rest or gone out of bounds and the edge of the fairway of the hole being played that is not nearer the hole with a 2 shot penalty.
- Provisional balls may be played on the 14th and 15th holes. See note on the Local Rule's Noticeboard or on the 14th tee.
- Compulsory replay of the ball when striking the white fairway marker poles on the 5th and 7th fairways.
- Free drop, no nearer the hole, from all areas marked with white lines and all heavy machinery tracks.
- Free place from all core holes and coring's.
- Free drop from all areas marked GUR
- All formed paths and roadways are GUR. Drop at the nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole.
- If you enter the greenkeeper's area, as marked, drop zones are provided with no penalty.
- Embedded ball through the green. Lift, clean and place. (*Through the green means the entire area of the golf course excluding the teeing ground, hazards, and putting green*).
- Free drop from newly sown areas.
- The area to the right of the 9th green and the island in the bunker on the 18th are classed as general areas.
- Call up holes – 3rd, 9th and 14th.

SPRINGFIELD GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS

All boundaries are indicated by white stakes, neighbouring property fences and the Utuhina Stream.

STAKED TREES

If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball may be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the Rules.

EMBEDDED BALL

Through the green, a ball which is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground, other than sand, may be lifted, cleaned and dropped without penalty as near as possible to where it lay not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

A player may not obtain relief under this Local Rule if it is clearly unreasonable for him to play a stroke because of interference by anything other than the condition covered by this Rule.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

All areas marked with white paint or GUR signs – Play off these areas is optional unless otherwise stated on the Local Rules Board.

WRONG PUTTING GREEN

The Chipping/Putting green at the rear of the Trundler Shed adjacent to the 10th green should be regarded as a "Wrong Putting Green" and relief taken as per Rule.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTION – 10TH HOLE

The fence along the new hockey pitch is an immovable obstruction and relief may be taken as per Rule.

TRUNDLERS, CARTS & MOTORBIKES

Please keep off greens and teeing areas. Also keep carts and motorbikes at least 5 metres away from the greens at all times.

DIVOTS & PITCH MARKS

Please take time to repair all pitch marks and divots.

BARRIER ROPED AREAS

These barrier ropes on some greens are in place to protect the area and players are asked not to take their trundlers over these areas. Using the 18th hole as an example please take your trundler around the green and not over the protected mounds.
