- Maximum New Zealand Golf Handicap Index of any one player to be 24.0 and the combined index of any team must be greater than 24.0;
- Limited to the first 50 teams in order of paid entry.
- Team practice rounds will be available on Thursday 15th November at either Arikikapakapa Golf Club or Springfield Golf Club, at cost to team players. \$40 per player booking times are essential.
- Use of golf carts must be pre approved. Those wishing to book carts or trundlers should do so directly with the Golf Clubs. Those bringing Golf Carts please note: No storage or charging facilities at the courses.
- Breakfast will be available at the golf courses – Bookings are required.
