**General Business**: **Invercargill** outlined their tournament, practice day 4<sup>th</sup> March and the tournament on the 5<sup>th</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>. Explaining that it is a flat course so a nice easy walk. There are direct flights from Auckland and Wellington. Plenty of accommodation with a restricted number of carts available and an information pack was available.

**Oxford** raised the cost of the tournament and how difficult it is to make ends meet at the current price and suggested that a remit be put in to raise the entry fee. St Johns raised the point that a remit was not required as it was up to the host club to set the fee and therefore the fee could be raised as early as next year. After general discussions it was agreed that clubs should set the fee according to their own circumstances. Hornby supported this and said that they found it very difficult last year to break even.

It was raised from the floor that 'Med Certs' should not be required and that any body should be able to bring their own personalised transport and use it. This was vigorously debated and turned down. So each player using a club cart or their own cart or any other form of personalised motorised transport should have a valid 'Med Cert' and have it available for inspection at registration.

A thank you to Pukekohe Cossie Club was raised form the floor with a round of applause. Teams were then announced for the 'Old Trophy' between North and South Islands.
