



## Clubs NZ Indoor Bowls Association South Island Indoor Bowls Tournament

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**TIME & ORDER of PLAY:** All play to be under New Zealand Federation Rules.

The Championships will be played as follows: All games will start and end with the whistles. At the final whistle the end in progress will be completed. ALL MATCHES WILL START STRICTLY TO TIME. Any Player or team not present when the whistle blows will be defaulted for that game. All Players are requested to be in attendance AT LEAST 10 MINUTES BEFORE their games are due to commence. Make sure your score card is in order before you hand it in. Do not forget to sign it. When your match is finished, leave your card on the mat and move to the next mat with as little delay as possible. Remember a strict timetable will be maintained.

Section Sheets will be placed in a prominent position. At the end of each round, the controller in charge will record the results of each game on these sheets, and it will be the responsibility of the team or player to see that their score is correctly recorded. Any errors should be notified to the controller in charge immediately.

At the end of each part of the section play: the qualifiers will be marked on these sheets, and all players are requested to make sure whether they have qualified before leaving the building.

**SECTION PLAY AND POST SECTION PLAY:** In all events section play will consist of four games:

<b>SINGLES</b>	12 ends with a time limit of 30 minutes
<b>PAIRS</b>	9 ends with a time limit of 35 minutes
<b>TRIPLES</b>	10 ends with a time limit of 40 minutes
<b>FOURS</b>	10 ends with a time limit of 50 minutes

Two points will be awarded for a win and one point for a draw. Those with five (5) points or more or section winners will qualify for post section play. All semis and finals will have no time limit.

**FINALS:** All finals will be of the same number of ends as competition, with no time limit. In the event of a drawn game, a deciding end will be played.

**REPLACEMENTS:** In the exceptional circumstances of illness of either player or a relative which requires the presence of a player elsewhere during post section play, the opportunity to provide a replacement should first be given to the player's club, should there not be a replacement available, then the host club provide one.

**SUIT ABLE FOOTWEAR:** Must be worn, and please refrain from walking on the mats any more than necessary, the controlling authority shall be the sole judge.
