Entry Fee:

He felt it was maybe too expensive when we are trying to promote the game and get younger players involved. Discussion took place. Some ideas put forward were mandatory sponsorship from clubs that had players entered, bringing the entry fee down, offering more to the sponsors for their money. **OUTCOME:** Vince Tate explained that the prize pool is always affected by the entry fee. It is up to the host club to set this. The minimum entry fee that can be charged is \$100.00.

Dress Code:

Lengthy discussion took place on this topic with many differing views. There are only a few tournaments where full kit is expected. **OUTCOME;** Yes, Snooker Etiquette to stay in place. Long Sleeved Shirt, Waistcoat / Vest, Dress shoes and Dress Trousers, Bowtie / Tie. These requirements to be stated on the Entry Form and to be enforced.
