

Minutes of the 12th CNZ NI Handicap Snooker Singles Snooker Tournament Annual General Meeting

Held at the Hamilton Cosmopolitan Club

Present: Chairman Terry Ray (CNZ Area Representative), Paul Phillips (Convenor, minutes Secretary), 11 delegates, 24 players.

Terry Ray welcomed all present.

Apologies: Nil

Absent friends: The chairman asked for a moments silence.

Minutes of 2018 Meeting: Moved Mike Hewer/Glenys Bardell "That the minutes of the 2018 meeting as presented were a True and Accurate Recording" Carried.

2020 Host: As advised at the 2018 Meeting, Hamilton Cosmopolitan Club.

Paul Phillips commented that this event began at the Hamilton Cosmopolitan Club in 2008 and the Club was looking forward to hosting the event in 2020. The Club has 8 tables, accommodation was within walking distance.

Paul apologised for the lack of clarity over qualification of 3rd place getters in section play and advised that in the future a committee will handle the organisation of the event.

2021 Host: There being only one application having been received by CNZ by the due date Hamilton Cosmopolitan Club will be the host for 2021. Darryl Jensen asked if Tauranga Citizens Club could submit an application for 2021. The Chair advised CNZ policy did not allow this. The meeting agreed that Tauranga Citizens Club be on standby for 2021.

General business: Roy and Diane Clark spoke about the unfairness of the best thirds from the morning not qualifying for post section play. It was again explained that the draw was set up to allow maximum games for all concerned, that waiting till all section play was completed to allow for what they considered to be fair would delay the whole tournament. (It is noted that by Roy and Diane Clark defaulting their last post section matches, this allowed other players who may not have qualified to qualify).

It was moved Darryl Jensen/Alex van den Einden that we get on with the Tournament.

Nicholas Ward Paihia expressed his thanks and appreciation and congratulations to the organisers for how the tournament was run and conducted.
