Meeting Opened 8.32am

Welcome by Chairperson Lee Davis

Apologies – Nil

Moments Silence in Remembrance of those that have passed away since last tournament.

Confirmation of 2018 tournament minutes held in Invercargill, 4th August 2018. Taken as read. Moved Lloyd Miller (Invercargill) Seconded Mike Hohaia (Richmond). Carried.

Matters Arising – Richmond notice of intent to host 2021 tournament withdrawn. Paul Chivers (Richmond).

Correspondence – Nil

Address by 2020 host club Gore RSA – Evan Fricker (Gore RSA) spoke to this. Everything progressing well.

Entry Fees – Entry fees for next years tournament shall remain the same. Moved Lloyd Miller (Invercargill) Seconded Nobby Yorwarth (Waimea). Carried.

Tournament Vote 2021 – applications taken from the floor. Clubs of Marlborough would like to host tournament in 2021. Moved Graham Henderson (COM) Seconded Peter Chandler (COM). Carried.

Remit –

Proposed addition to Rules, to become part of Rule1.(c):

(c) Teams must enter under the name of one club only, (existing) but in the event of extenuating circumstances which would cause a team to be one player short, the Host Club shall have the right to include a replacement player, thus enabling the team to compete in the tournament. Such a team will be eligible for all prizes except the major prize.

Paul Chivers (Richmond) spoke on the remit as just a tidy up for sickness or extenuating circumstances before play commences. There was a general agreeance that occurrences after tournament started was just an unfortunate situation. Colin Bowden (Waimea) had put forward the remit forward with the assistance of Kate Smith (Sports Advisor at Clubs NZ).

Remit Moved Nobby Yorwarth (Waimea) Seconded Paul Chivers (Richmond). Carried.

General Business –

Programme – Adopted after general discussion that tournament venue to be added to past winners and year in programme. Used to be included.

Dress Code – Lloyd Miller (Invercargill) said Host Club is responsible for the dress code being adhered to. Nathan Geddes (Waimea) said there needs to be a general tidy up of the rules. Evan Fricker (Gore) mentioned about emblmed club shirts being able to be worn in some tournaments. Paul Chivers (Richmond) suggested that a remit be formulated for next years meeting.

Refereeing - Lloyd Miller (Invercargill) said when player sare refereeing other games they should be at table not standing away from it, otherwise they can't see what is going on. Ivan Hall (Richmond) agreed and suggested it be mentioned when rules are discussed at players meeting at start of tournament. Evan Fricker (Gore) said it should be put in programme. All agreed.

Foul and Miss Rule – Nathan Geddes (Waimea) suggests rule should only be enforced 3 times. There is a NZ rule going through at next years AGM regarding foul and miss interpretation. Ivan Hall (Richmond) also spoke to this and said that the referee is the only one who can make the call. Suggested a remit for next years meeting.

Lloyd Miller (Invercargill) recorded a vote of thanks to the Clubs of Marlborough for hosting the tournament.

Meeting Closed 9.13am.
