Billiards – Tournament Conditions

Format

Section Play shall be the best of three (3) games *150 up. Top four will qualify for post section play and will be decided by number of match wins. If wins are equal then game difference will determine qualifiers. If still equal, a one game 150 up play off.

Post Section Matches

Championship: Best of 5 games *150 up

Championship Final: Best of 7 games *150 up (time permitting)

Plate Matches: Best of 3 games *150 up (all matches)

Time Penalties

Time Penalties will be enforced. Players not at their table ready to play 10 minutes after being called will be penalized 4 points per minute for the next 10 minutes at which stage games will be forfeited. The same penalty will apply to subsequent games until match forfeiture.

Dress Standard

Plain Coloured, long sleeved dress shirt and bow tie. Dress trousers and dress shoes. Waistcoat and Club Jerseys' are optional.

Final: Best of 7 Frames (time permitting)
Plate / Final: Best of 3 Frames (all matches)

Referees:

Players not playing to referee other matches.

Time Penalties

Time Penalties will be enforced. Players not at their table ready to play 10 minutes after being called will be penalized 4 points per minute for the next 10 minutes at which stage games will be forfeited. The same penalty will apply to subsequent games until match forfeiture.
